

NAVIGATING (TO AND WITHIN) NASSP 2016

Powerpoint

If you plan to use PowerPoint, please bring your file on a usb drive, either to load on the classroom computer or as a backup. Cables and connectors will be available to project from laptops, but only the most common Mac adaptors, so, if you have your own Mac adaptor, please bring it as a precaution.

Orientation

You will need to identify at most four buildings on campus

- All sessions are held in the **River Building, RB** on the map
- Room check-in and lunches: **Residence Commons, CO** on the map
- If you are staying on campus, you will be in either **Frontenac (FR)** or **Lennox & Addington (LX)**
- Additional lunch options Thursday & Friday: **University Centre, UC** on the map

Arrival Information

Canadian currency can be obtained from ATMs at the airport, bus terminal, VIA Rail station, hotels, and campus, or from a currency exchange kiosk at the airport. The Canadian dollar is exchanging at between 72 and 78 cents US. Public buses take \$3.65 exact change when you board. (If you want to pay more, Ottawa will thank you but will not give change back.) Buses give paper transfers that are good for travel on connecting buses and light rail (O-Train). If the O-Train is the first vehicle for your trip, use ticket machines at the station, which accept cards+cash and give transfers. Taxis take visa (+ service charge).

From the airport

- To downtown hotels: (a) \$30 taxi or (b) \$3.65 bus (#97) to Albert & Metcalfe + 5 minute walk to hotels.
- To Carleton University: (a) \$23 taxi or (b) \$3.65 bus (#97) to Greenboro, take a paper transfer, take O-Train to Carleton University.

From Greyhound Bus or VIA Rail stations

- From Greyhound station (a) \$11 taxi or (b) walk 5 minutes to Bank Street, take #7 bus (\$3.65) to Carleton, ask the driver to stop at Residence Commons.
- From VIA Rail station (a) \$18 taxi or (b) take a westbound bus (\$3.65) to Bayview station (ask the driver if the bus goes that far), retain the paper transfer you are given and take the O-Train two stops to Carleton, exit the station onto Campus Avenue + walk to Residence Commons or River Building.

By car to Carleton University: enter from Bronson Avenue, bear right and then left to Campus Avenue (see map).

- Park outside Residence Commons while checking in.
- Conference sessions are held in the River Building at the end of Campus Avenue.
- For parking near River Building, take University Drive left after the River Building, and follow it to the parking garage. Walk from the parking garage through the railway underpass to the River Building.

By taxi, bus, or O-Train to campus

- By taxi or bus, ask the driver to stop at Residence Commons (for check-in) or the River Building (for sessions).
- From the O-Train, exit to Campus Avenue and walk south (towards the river) to the River Building, or north to Residence Commons.

Lunches

Lunches are available throughout the conference at Residence Commons: sandwiches at Tim Hortons or fixed price all-you-can-eat at Fresh Food Company. Ask about prices when you check in; the cost of a lunch for people not staying at the residence is \$11.70 plus tax. **Thursday and Friday** lunches are also available at Tim Hortons in the River Building and at the University Centre food court (5 minutes from River Building, see map).

Lunches can be purchased at Residence Commons.

Conference location: registration, all sessions, and the book display will take place in the River Building.
